Open to all students with at least a Bachelor's degree in graphic design or equivalent, the Master in Graphic design for Art Direction aims to **train Art Directors with international career ambitions**. Working on multi-cultural projects abroad or in international units. Art direction, graphic design and communication design are viewed through the prism of foreign countries and their specific **cultural characteristics**.

Based on **project-based teaching**, the 2-year Master in Graphic Design & Art Direction programme is made up of 7 modules of 6 weeks each. In each of these modules, students will have the opportunity to study **1 geographical area**, **1 societal theme and 1 or 2 professional disciplines***. This programme is offered in Paris, a capital renowned worldwide for its influence in the creative professions.

ADMISSION PROCESS

September: international admissions open. We accept applications throughout the year depending on the number of places available. Non-European students are advised to apply before the end of June to facilitate consular formalities.

Our international admissions procedure consists of 4 stages.

PREPARING THE APPLICATION

VALIDATION OF THE APPLICATION AND INTERVIEW IN ENGLISH

An initial interview with the admissions officer to assess the applicant's level of English.

ADMISSION TO THE PROGRAMME

The student's admission is confirmed. Students have 15 days (flexible deadline) to confirm their enrollment.

REGISTER FOR THE PROGRAMME - EU students:

Once you have paid the registration fee of €450, I'ECV will confirm your definitive enrolment. - Non-EU students: Confirmation of definitive enrolment after payment of the enrolment fee + deposit: €3200

An official notification of registration will be sent within 72 hours, which will enable you to start the consular procedures and obtain the corresponding VISA.
